Information clause – mailing

In accordance with Article 13 (1) and (2) as well as Article 14 (1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation –hereinafter referred to as GDPR), Institute of Agrophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences (IA PAS) informs that:

1. The Controller of personal data processed for the abovementioned purposes is the Institute of Agrophysics, Polish Academy of Sciences, Str. Doświadczalna 4, 20-290 Lublin POLAND, www.ipan.lublin.pl
2. The Data Protection Officer is Mr Krzysztof Kajdrowicz e-mail: k.kajdrowicz@ipan.lublin.pl
3. The processing of your personal data (e-mail or correspondence address, contact phone number) is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest to disseminate the results of scientific research (Article 6(1e) of the GDPR) while organising scientific Events (e.g. meetings, conferences, conventions, symposia). The abovementioned task is laid down by the Statute of the IA PAS of 10 May 2011.
4. Your personal data is processed solely for the purpose of providing information on Events organized by the IA PAS.
5. The personal data possessed was collected: directly from the data subject; from the IA PAS' employees, who claim that data subjects are persons potentially interested in Events organized by the IA PAS; or from publicly available sources (e.g. your employer's websites, scientific publications, etc.).
6. Personal data collected for the performance of the task set out in point 3. (e.g. for archive purposes) will be stored for the period specified by the Act of 14 July 1983 on National Archival Resources and Archives (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 217, as amended).
7. The Controller does not intend to transfer personal data to a third country or an international organisation.
8. Your personal data shall not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
9. The data subject has the right to access, rectify, delete, restrict processing, transfer the collected data, the right to object, to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. However, these rights may be limited when the Controller is legally obliged to process data in order to comply with the statutory obligations.
10. In case of finding that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the EU GDPR of 27 April 2016, everyone is entitled to file a complaint to the President of Personal Data Protection Office.
