- iii) monitoring and modeling soil properties and processes, including water flow, heat transfer, and the transport of various substances (nutrients, pollutants, colloids) in soil;
- iv) the use of these properties and relationships in solving practical and scientific environmental problems.

The abstract should include the title, the names and affiliations of the authors, a short assessment of the research to be presented, keywords, and acknowledgments if applicable.

Oral presentations should be 12 minutes long with an additional 3 minutes provided for questions and answers.

Poster presentations will have a special section where all presenters will have 3 minutes to provide a short summary of their research.
